

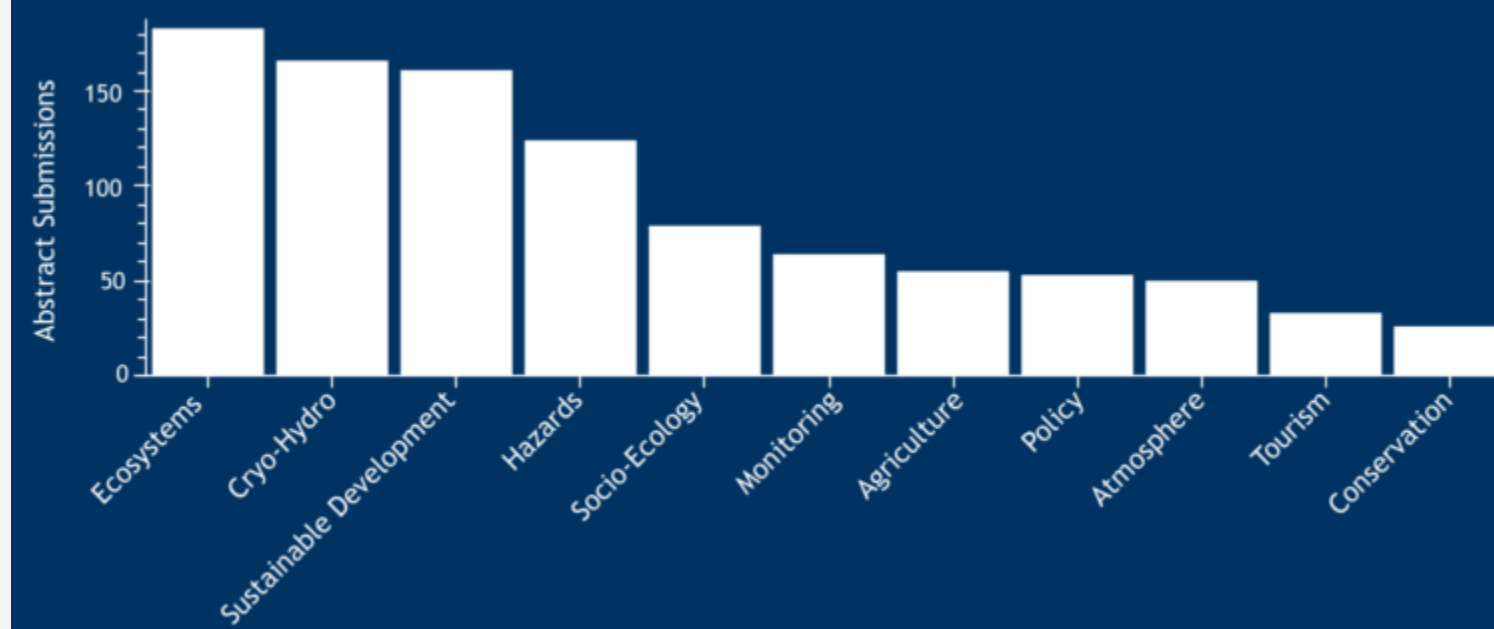

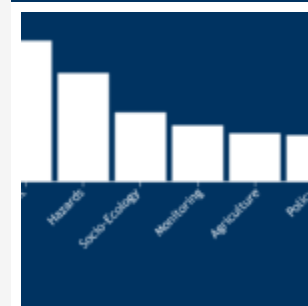

Submissions in thematic fields

Overall, we currently have 776 submissions to IMC2022. Out of interest, we analyzed the amount of contributions per (to some extent arbitrary) session categories. The results are plotted in the image above (please be aware that several submissions are counted in more than one category). Luckily it looks like that in all fields there are (plenty) of colleagues to exchange and discuss your research with.

Still late abstract submissions - start of registration postponed

As the overall number of submissions was already relatively high (>700) and we have received more than 50 late abstract submissions in the meantime, we start the registration period a few days later than planned (start now March 28th). This helps us to thoroughly complete the review process and to enable a smooth registration process (early bird fees will be valid until April 27th) - a reminder will of course follow!



IMC2019 Synthesis paper published

At IMC2019, various and quite diverse mountain research topics were discussed in [41 workshops](#). Although the workshop outputs were almost as diverse as the topics, thanks to the support of almost all workshop moderators it was possible to synthesize them in a paper.
